Ric Berman researches, writes and speaks on eighteenth and nineteenth-century English, Irish and American freemasonry. A Fellow of the Royal Historical Society, he is the author of numerous journal articles and books and has delivered keynote papers across the globe. Ric holds an MA and PhD from the University of Cambridge and the University of Exeter, respectively, and undertook post-doctoral research at the University of Oxford's Modern European History Research Centre. A Freemason for over forty years and twice a Prestonian Lecturer, Ric holds Grand Rank in the United Grand Lodge of England and is a Past Master of three English Lodges including Quatuor Coronati, the premier lodge of Masonic research. He is also an American Freemason and a Fellow of the Philalethes Society. Born in London, Ric lives in rural Oxfordshire.
